Seaspan's contracted fleet of 69 containerships consists of 61 containerships in operation and eight containerships scheduled for delivery through March 2012. Seaspan's operating fleet of 61 vessels has an average age of approximately five years and an average remaining charter period of approximately seven years. All of the eight vessels to be delivered to Seaspan are already committed to fixed-rate time charters of 12 years in duration from delivery. Seaspan's customer base consists of eight of the world's largest liner companies, including A.P. Moller-Maersk A/S, China Shipping Container Lines (Asia) Co., Ltd., Compania Sud Americana de Vapores S.A., COSCO Container Lines Co., Ltd., Hapag-Lloyd USA, LLC, Kawasaki Kisen Kaisha Ltd., Mitsui O.S.K.
